

How Can I Help My Child?

Basic Necessities To Bring To School Daily:

- 1. Pencil case with two (2B) pencils, an eraser, a ruler and a sharpener
- 2. 1 small box of 12 coloured pencils
- 3. Water bottle
- 4. Packed food to eat during recess <u>OR</u> money and food container to buy food from the canteen during recess
- 5. Healthy snacks to eat during Snack Break
