2. Museum-Based Learning to National Gallery of Singapore for Primary 4 Students

The school is integrating Museum-Based Learning (MBL) into its Visual Arts curriculum to provide pupils with authentic and holistic learning experience. MBL helps develop visual inquiry skills of observation and interpretation through activities and discussions. Pupils will also learn to reflect on artworks by local and international artists and develop an awareness of Singaporean art

Using Visual Art as a learning tool, this programme will use a multi-disciplinary approach to nurture and develop 21st century competencies and Character & Citizenship Education.

The school will be organising its inaugural learning journey to the National Gallery Singapore (NGS) for our Primary 4 students between 1 July 2019 and 30 August 2019. It will be conducted after curriculum hours. A detailed notification will be sent to all parents nearer to the date of visit. A briefing will be conducted for the pupils on their groupings, schedule and the teachers-in-charge.

3. Supporting your child; being involved.

The Semestral Assessment 1 will commence in Week 6. Here are some suggestions for you to support your child as he/she prepares for the assessment.

- Cheer your child on by being positive of his/her efforts.
- Keep learning fun for your child through mind-mapping exercises, quiz show-like verbal exchanges and relating their topic of study to everyday life.
- Motivate your child with the intrinsic rewards instead of extrinsic rewards.
- Care for the mind and body (have regular breaks and physical exercise to help your child learn more efficiently and effectively)
- Plan and prepare through mindful reinforcement of examination techniques (planning their time for each subject paper, identifying key words, setting aside time to check their work, etc.)
