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2. International Friendship Day 2021

Theme: Singapore In The World

The school will be commemorating International Friendship Day on Term 2 Week 3 (5 Apr 2021 – 9 Apr 2021) for our pupils to reflect on the importance of Singapore's cross-cultural skills and global orientation. At the same time, it is also important for our pupils to learn the importance of demonstrating mutual respect and understanding to maintain social cohesion in our multi-cultural society.

As part of the celebrations, the school will be organizing a donation drive for the migrant workers from 5 Apr to 9 Apr 2021. We hope to instil in our pupils the values of appreciation and gratitude towards migrant workers in our nation. The donation drive is in collaboration with *Raining Raincoats* and *Social Collider*. Following are some daily necessities that we will be collecting through this donation drive:

1. Toothpaste (approx. 200-250g)
2. Toothbrush
3. Soap
4. Hand sanitizer (approx. 50-100ml)
5. Wet tissue packets
6. Face mask (in sealed packets)
7. Halal instant noodles (5 in a pack)
8. Halal canned food (approx. 350-400g)

Pupils are encouraged to bring any of the above items to school during the collection week. They are to place the donated items at a designated space in the classrooms. Each class will be given 3 large tote bags to fill in the donated items. C4RE teachers will assist in the packing of items at the end of the week. We hope that you can join us in this effort to show kindness and bring smiles to the migrant workers' faces.

b) Primary 3 & Primary 5 Weighted Assessment 1

Since 2020, to reduce over-emphasis on grades, the school has re-adjusted the assessment plans for Primary 3 & 5. Weighted Assessments have been introduced to provide timely feedback to address of learning gaps and support students learning. These bite-sized weighted assessments are conducted during Terms 2 and 3. They constitute a total of 30% of the overall assessment weightage for the year.

Pupils from Primary 3 & 5 will be having their Weighted Assessment 1 during Term 2 Week 5 & 6 (19 Apr to 27 Apr 2021). Their subject teachers will inform them of the dates of the various subjects nearer the assessment period.
